1. Declarations of interest

2. Report of 10th October 2017 meeting

Matters Arising from the Report

a) Contact with Social Housing Groups

T Weston reported on his collaboration with County Councillor Barry Durkin in contacting Social Housing Groups with regard to developing the sites identified at Old Pyke and Hazerdine. Although some interest was expressed, the small sites did not offer economies of scale in their development. It was anticipated that the Social Housing Groups would look into this further.

The Working Party was reminded that the need in the Ross-on-Wye Local Housing Market Area had been identified as being for Social/Affordable and 2/3 bedroomed properties and that the term 'Affordable' referred to housing at 80% of market value.

b) Cycle Loop

The Chairman sought and gained the approval of the Working Party to contact Bella Johnson of the Ledbury Cycling Group to consult about a proposed Cycle Loop in the Parish (draft NDP Issue T12). The Parish Council is likely to be involved in the outcome of this consultation.

3. Progress Report on the Production of the Neighbourhood Plan

The Chairman reported on his recent contacts with Foxley-Tagg Planning and their response in the production of the final Regulation 15 draft NDP.

K Johnson of Herefordshire Planning had requested early sight of the final Regulation 15 draft NDP to enable amendments of the SEA/HRA.

He requested the support of Working Party members R Jolly and J Finnigan in checking the final Regulation 15 draft NDP when available.

Settlement Maps produced by J Weston were presented and formally accepted by the meeting for inclusion in the final Regulation 15 draft NDP. J Weston was thanked for her contribution.

It was noted that the maps would be re-drawn by Herefordshire Planning in the final publication of the Neighbourhood Plan so that a consistent standard could be applied across all published Neighbourhood Plans in the county.

The Chairman hoped that the final Regulation 15 draft NDP submission would be placed before the Parish Council at their meeting on 13 December.

ACTION

Once finalised, the Regulation 15 draft NDP would be forwarded to T Weston in order for him to arrange the production of printed copies for Working Party members and Parish Councillors before their respective meetings on 12 and 13 December.

4. Summary of Process for Regulation 15 Submission

ACTION

The Regulation 15 draft NDP would be forwarded to K Johnson to enable amendments of the SEA/HRA.

ACTION

In addition to the Consultation Summary Report, the formal Regulation 15 submission process requires a written Consultation Statement and Compliance Statement (with NPPF, NPPG & Core Strategy policies). The chairman proposed to prepare summary versions of both statements in tabular form.

ACTION

5. Planning Applications Glebe Orchard and Land adjacent to Roseland, Dymock Road

Brief reference was made to the two current outline planning applications.

ACTION

The Chairman was requested to contact K Johnson concerning the impact on the Regulation 15 draft NDP submission process should approval be granted to either or both of these applications.

There may be a need to revisit the Regulation 15 draft NDP in these circumstances.

The observation was made that Herefordshire Council has advised that draft NDP does not become material until after Regulation 16 consultation has been completed.

ACTION

The Chairman was asked to attempt to gain the support of County Councillor Barry Durkin to contact the Senior Planning Officers of Herefordshire to request 'call in' for decisions by Committee, rather than delegated officer decision, of the current applications with some material consideration of the Regulation 15 draft NDP.
