BBLP do not keep a store of sand bags for these issues but they do have responsibility for the ditches and drains adjacent to the highway etc. that will provide relief to the excessive rain and weather. There needs to be more education, persuasion and if necessary enforcement of instances where the requirements of riparian responsibilities for landowners.

Budget Consultation

Herefordshire Council has launched an online budget consultation running from now till Friday 8th January. The budget assumes a total Council Tax increase of 4.99%. This would be made from an increase of 1.99% to core Council Tax which would contribute £2.2 million towards council services. A social care precept of 3% would contribute a further £3.2 million to be used on social care services.

Have your say by **midnight Friday 8 January 2021**. The received feedback will be considered by full Council on **12 February 2021**.
