# 3. Report 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2016

f) Rushall Settlement Boundary

The straightening of the boundary to include the orchard on the south easterly side of the cross-roads was proposed. This is to be confirmed at the next meeting.

#### 5. Much Marcle Settlement Boundary

Members were recommended to visit the Walwyn Court site to study the new development. Concern was expressed about the dangers of encroachment towards Helens. A decision would be made at the next meeting.

# 6. Review of Local Green Space Boundary at Swan Cottage

J Gibbon expressed a family interest.

The field was noted to contain an ancient ditch.

Members felt that they did not fully comprehend the implications of including/not including the house and barn in the local green space and decided to review the situation at the next meeting. Members were requested to forward any information that they came across concerning the criterea used for development in nominated green space.
