DESCRIPTION: Replacement mash tank building – Retrospective.

Planning Consultation 232786 – Field adjacent to Much Marcle Primary School, Much Marcle, Ledbury, Herefordshire, HR8 2LY. DESCRIPTION: Trees on boundary of field – where necessary crown raise boundary trees on field side by removing low branches up to 5 metres above ground level to allow access for mowing equipment and prevent encroachment of field. SUPPORTED

DESCRIPTION: T1- Lime situated in playground on south side, lift canopy to 6 metres above ground level. T2 – Oak situated adjacent to staff car park and overhanging play area, lift canopy to 5 metres above ground level. T3 – Three large Hawthorn on boundary with agricultural field, reduce to half metre inside fence. SUPPORTED

DESCRIPTION: To extend and alter rear single storey kitchen. SUPPORT subject to use of suitable materials to match the existing structures.
